




COME, YE SINNERS, POOR AND NEEDY




1. Come, ye sin-ners, poor and need - y, Weak and wound-ed, sick and sore;

Ven - ture on Him, ven - ture whol - ly; Let no oth - er trust in - trude.




WE HAVE COME TO JOIN IN WORSHIP




